Youth Peace Camp

Coming Together and Working in a Good Way



The UAVS Youth Peace Camp is an initiative to address racism and discrimination in a peaceful and productive way.

Based on Indigenous Practice of circle making, this initiative provides opportunity for youth to build cultural identity, learn cultural practices for restoring harmony in relationships.



The youth in the Peace Camp use their tipi to build an encampment and call a circle wherever they see the need to address bullying, discrimination and racism in the world around them



In practicing these methods, the youth promote a more peaceful and just world today and for the next seven generations.



Youth are trained as peace makers from Cree, Blackfoot and Metis traditions:

- Blanket Exercise Facilitation
- No Such Thing as a Bully facilitator training
- Leadership on the Medicine Wheel
- Tipi and Cultural Teachings
- Peace making circles
- ART - Anti-Racism & Discrimination Response Training
